

CPSIA Statement

Preferred Nation always strives to deliver excellence and peace of mind in all our products. We make sure that our items are designed and produced with high quality while maintaining compliance with the New Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) regulations currently in effect. We are also constantly working with our vendors and supply chain partners to ensure they meet federal and local health and safety laws.

In August 2008, Congress introduced the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) to regulate the levels of lead in paint and surface coating for all components in children's products. In August 2009, a revision of the acceptable lead levels was made, demanding levels to be less than 300 ppm in substrates and 90 ppm in surface coatings.

While Preferred Nation's products are not designed for, nor intended for, children 12 and under, we realize that some customers may sell the items to the youth market, where to be used by children under 12. We therefore offer a selection of products that have been tested through 3rd party laboratories, who have issued official certificates that can be provided upon request.

Preferred Nation will continue to monitor changes in the CPSIA regulations in order to ensure compliance with all applications and regulations.
